

Overnight Walker Registration Scheme



The Parks and Wildlife Service provides an Overnight Walker Registration Scheme to assist in ensuring you have a safe and enjoyable walk. We strongly recommend that you take advantage of this scheme.

The Registration Scheme

- is voluntary
- requires a refundable deposit of \$50/person or \$200/group
- is only for the designated overnight walks listed on this sheet
- will ensure search and rescue begins if you do not deregister by 12 noon on the day following your nominated day of completion
- fully refunds the deposit when you deregister
- does not provide current information on track conditions and access. You should contact the Parks & Wildlife Service Regional Office before commencing your walk.

To Register

You can register with **credit card** details by telephoning: **1300 650 730** for the cost of a local call.

You can register in person with a **cash deposit** at the following locations:

- Central Australian Tourism, Gregory Terrace, Alice Springs

- Katherine Regional Tourist Association, Cnr of Stuart Highway and Lindsay St.
- Darwin Regional Tourism Association, Cnr Knuckey and Mitchell Streets.

Please note:

If you pay with a cash deposit, it will be refunded by cheque only and mailed to your nominated address.

You will need to provide:

- Credit card details (number, type, expiry date and the cardholder's name) or a cash deposit or cheque
- Group leader's name and address
- Names of other people in the group
- Emergency contact name and telephone number
- The route you plan to take including your start point and finishing point
- Camp sites you plan to use
- Commencement date and completion date
- Vehicle, registration, make, model, type and colour of each vehicle
- The location of your vehicle (if any) in the park or reserve.
- The name of your accommodation the night after your walk.

To Deregister

Your deposit will be fully refunded to the group leader, only when you deregister after

Safety and Comfort

- Observe park safety signs
- Do not walk alone
- Carry and drink plenty of water
- Wear a shady hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, suitable clothing and footwear
- Avoid strenuous activity during the heat of the day
- Consider your health and fitness when choosing a walk

Please Remember

- Keep to designated roads and tracks
- All historic, cultural items and wildlife are protected
- Pets are not permitted on walking tracks or in most parks
- Use fuel stoves where possible
- Camping is only permitted in designated camping areas
- Bins are not provided, please take your rubbish with you
- Contact Parks and Wildlife for fact sheets and other information

completing your walk.

Deregistration is required no later than 12 noon the day following your nominated completion date.

If deregistration is not made without just cause prior to 12 noon you will forfeit your deposit.

Giles Track - George Gill Range, Watarrka National Park.
