Tabletop Track

The Department of Natural Resources, Environment, The Arts and Sport (NRETAS) advises that the Tabletop Track in Litchfield National Park will be accessible by permit for the wet season.

Tabletop Track is a 39km long distance walk suitable for experienced, fit and prepared bushwalkers, who are willing to carry their own supplies and camp with minimal facilities.

Access to the track will only be provided for permit holders for the duration of the wet season, this is a safety measure which is adopted each wet season due to high temperatures and humidity.

Visitors intending to access the Tabletop Track can apply for a free permit through the Northern Territory Parks and Wildlife Service on 8999 4795 or at www.nt.gov.au/nreta/parks.

The permits ensure visitors are given appropriate advice on conditions to prepare for the walk, as well as recording their details for visitor safety.

All other attractions within Litchfield National Park are currently open.
