

Amend Waste Discharge Licence

Section 93 Water Act 1992

WDL Form 93

An application to amend a waste discharge licence in accordance with section 93 of the *Water Act 1992* should be lodged at least 60 business days prior to the expiry of the Licence. Applicants are advised that where an application is received within 60 business days of the expiry of a waste discharge licence it is unlikely that the application will be processed prior to expiry of the waste discharge licence.
