## **Permanent Declaration of Heritage Place: Sea Rights Yingapungapu**

I, Chanston James Paech, Minister for Arts, Culture and Heritage:

- (a) under section 34(1) of the *Heritage Act 2011*, permanently declare the place known as Sea Rights Yingapungapu, described in Schedule 1, to be a heritage place; and
- (b) under section 34(2)(a) of the Act, authorise the work specified in Schedule 2 as work that may be carried out on the heritage place declared by paragraph (a) without a work approval.

**Schedule 2            Authorised work**

- (ii) the Tiwi Land Council established under the *Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976* (Cth).
