Description of Activity:	The Naval Superintendent, HMAS Coonawarra, Royal Australian Navy has declared the following restrictions for vessels operating in the Closed and Controlled waters off HMAS Coonawarra.		
	Closed Naval Waters. These are the waters landward of the Special Buoys installed approximately 200m from the land.		
	a. Vessels are not permitted to enter, transit, loiter, anchor, moor or engage in activities within Closed Naval Waters without express approval, or to conduct any activity incidental or necessary to ensure the safety of the Vessel, or assist another Vessel in distress.		
	b. Closed Naval Waters may be enforced by a Navy security patrol vessel or Police members of the Northern Territory Police for the purposes of communicating and exercising powers concerning the placing or removal of the Vessels in declared Naval Waters.		
	Controlled Naval Waters. These are the waters seaward of the Special Buoys, to the boundary of the Declared Naval Waters.		
	<ul> <li>Vessels may enter Controlled Naval Waters for the purpose of expeditious transit and giving way to another Vessel.</li> </ul>		
	<ul> <li>b. Vessels must not moor or anchor within Controlled Naval Waters at any time, unless approved, or to conduct any activity incidental or</li> </ul>		



	necessary to ensure the safety of the Vessel, or assist another Vessel in distress.		
	<ul> <li>vessels must transit expeditiously through Controlled Naval Waters.</li> <li>In all circumstances, vessels must not loiter by remaining in Controlled</li> <li>Naval Waters for any period longer than is reasonably necessary.</li> </ul>		
	d. Fishing from a Vessel by any means, is prohibited in Controlled Naval Waters.
