Revocation and Determination of Rent Payable for Dwellings: Government Employee Housing

- I, Steven Mark Edgington, Minister for Housing, Local Government and Community Development, with effect commencing on 1 October 2024:
- (a) under section 23 of the Housing Act 1982 and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act 1978, revoke the instrument entitled 'Revocation and Determination of Rent Payable for Dwellings: Government Employee Housing' dated 29 January 2024 and published in Gazette No. S3 of 30 January 2024; and
- (b) under section 23 of the *Housing Act 1982*, determine that the rent to be paid each week for a dwelling described in the Schedule is \$105 multiplied by the number of bedrooms in the dwelling.

A dwelling, known as Government Employee Housing, leased under regulation 7 of the *Housing Regulations 1983* to an employee of the Territory.
