SCHEDULE OF NOTES

- 1. A registered covenant or covenant in gross may be amended by registering an instrument of amendment of the covenant or covenant in gross. However, the instrument of amendment must not change a party to the covenant or covenant in gross.
- 2. This form is to be lodged as an original only and must be typed or completed in ink or biro. The imprint of the Commissioner of Territory Revenue must be shown. Alterations to information entered on the form should be crossed out (nor erased or obliterated by painting over) and initialled by the parties.
- 3. If there is insufficient space in any panel use the space above or an annexure sheet (Form 95).
- 4. A description of the covenant must be given together with the LTO registration number if applicable
- 5. Volume and Folio references must be given together with complete parcel description. If the certificate as to title has been issued it must be produced.
- 6. Insert the owner of the land burdened by the covenant. Address is not required.
- 7. Volume and Folio references must be given together with complete parcel description. If the certificate as to title has been issued it must be produced.
- 8. Insert the owner or person receiving the benefit of the covenant. Address is not required.

- 10. Persons who may witness this document are a Commissioner for Oaths, a member of the Legislative Assembly, a legal practitioner within the meaning of the Legal Profession Act 2006, a person holding office under the Supreme Court Act 1979, the Justices of the Peace Act 1991, the Local Court Act 2015 or the Registration Act 1927, a Notary Public and any other person approved by the Registrar-General.

A witness to an instrument executed by an individual must first:

- take reasonable steps to ensure that the individual is the person entitled to sign the instrument;
- have the individual execute the document in the presence of the witness;
- not be a party to the instrument; and
- if witnessing more than one signature, clearly state that he/she has witnessed more than one signature. (ie I have witnessed the two signatures appearing above).
