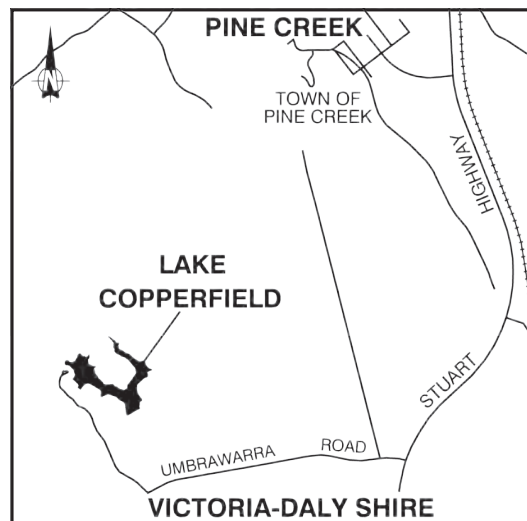

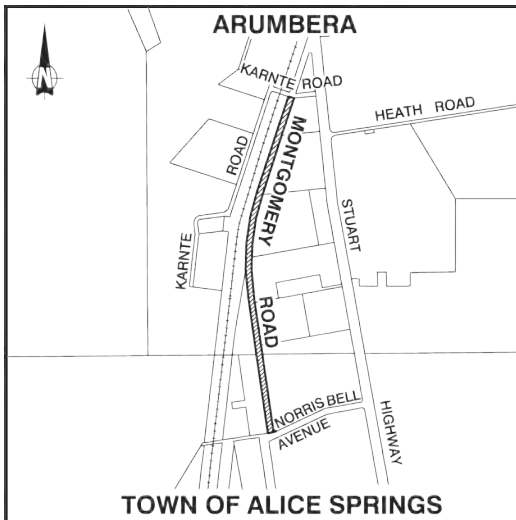

**Tobacco Control Regulations**

**DECLARATION OF HIGH ROLLER ROOMS  
WITHIN CASINO**

I, DELIA PHOEBE LAWRIE, Minister for Racing, Gaming and Licensing:

- (a) under regulation 8A(1) of the *Tobacco Control Regulations*, declare each of the following areas in the casino at Skycity Darwin to be a high roller room:
  - (i) VIP Gaming Salon at Horizon 801;
  - (ii) VIP Gaming Salon at Horizon 802; and
- (b) under regulation 8A(2) of the *Tobacco Control Regulations*, specify that the declaration in paragraph (a) is subject to the following conditions:
  - (i) the ratio of operating gaming tables located in the room to operating gaming machines located in the room must not be less than 1 table to not more than 5 machines;

- (ii) the total number of gaming machines located in the room must not exceed 10;
- (iii) entry into the room for gaming is restricted to local, interstate or international visitors to the casino who are individual casino patrons specifically invited to the room;
- (iv) a register of all patron numbers and places of residence must be kept and reported to the Director of Licensing.
