# Anyone that owns European Honey Bees (EHB) within the Northern Territory must register their hives in accordance with regulations 50 and 51 of the *Northern Territory Livestock Regulations*, 2009.

Once your registration is processed, a one off unique hive identification number (HIN) will be issued. This number is required to be displayed on all of your managed hives (brood boxes) for easy identification and to aide with traceability, should a biosecurity event occur.

Your registration period is two years, after which time, you will need to renew it. It is your responsibility to keep your information up to date, including movement of apiary sites and transference of ownership (including increase or decrease of hive numbers).
