#### Revocation of General Reservation of Land



- (a) revoke the reservation made by notice entitled "Notice of Intention to Reserve Land from Occupation EL 7970" dated 25 May 2010 and published in *Gazette* No. G29 on 21 July 2010, with effect on the date this notice is published in the *Gazette*; and




# NOTICE OF PROPOSED GRANT OF EXPLORATION PERMIT (PETROLEUM)

PETROLEUM ACT (NT) SECTION 18 NATIVE TITLE ACT 1993 (CTH) SECTION 29

The Honourable Nicole Manison MLA, the Northern Territory Minister for Mining and Industry, c/- Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade, GPO Box 4550 DARWIN NT 0801 or Centrepoint Building, 48-50 Smith Street Mall, DARWIN NT 0800, hereby gives notice in accordance with section 18 of the Petroleum Act 1984 (NT) and section 29 of the Native Title Act 1993 (Cth) that application has been made for, and the Minister intends to grant, Exploration Permit (Petroleum) ("Permit") under Division 2 of Part II of the Petroleum Act 1984 (NT) as follows.

Application to which this notice applies:





Nature of act(s): The grant of a permit under the Petroleum Act 1984, gives the person to whom it is granted the exclusive right, for a term of up to 5 years, to explore for petroleum and to carry on such operations and execute such works as are necessary for that purpose in the area covered by the permit including (but not limited to) use of machinery and equipment for carrying out works, removal of material for testing, use of water resources for domestic use and to seek renewals. A permit may be renewed no more than twice. If petroleum is discovered in a permit area, production licences and/or retention licences may subsequently be granted. Further information about the Petroleum Act 1984 may be obtained from the Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade.

Native Title Parties: Any person who is, or becomes a "native title party" within the meaning of the Native Title Act 1993 is entitled to the negotiation and/or procedural rights provided in Part 2, Division 3, Subdivision P of the Native Title Act 1993. Under section 30 of the Native Title Act 1993, persons have until 3 months after the notification day to take certain steps to become native title parties in relation to this notice. Enquiries concerning becoming a native title party should be directed to the National Native Title Tribunal GPO Box 9973 ADELAIDE SA 5001, telephone (08) 8205 2000.

Objections under Section 19 of the Petroleum Act: Pursuant to section 19 of the Petroleum Act 1984, a person who has an estate or interest in relation to land compromised in, or land contiguous with land comprised in, an area covered by the proposed grant may, within 2 months after the notification day, lodge in writing an objection to the proposed grant. Such objection may be lodged at the Office of the Minister for Mining and Industry c/- Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade, Notification Day: For the purposes of section 29(4) of the Native Title Act 1993, the notification day is 27 July 2022.
