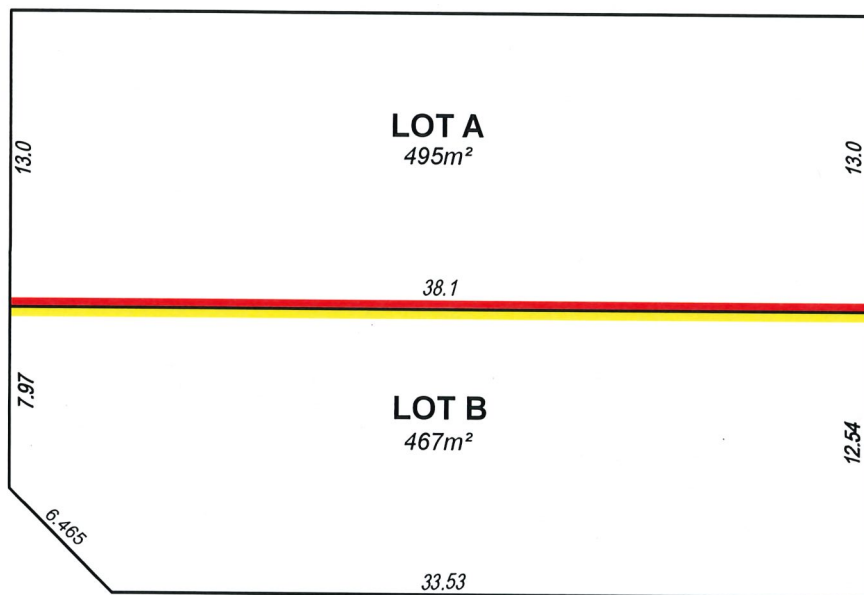
1. Citation

Reasons for Decision

NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020
AMENDMENT No. 91

Pursuant to Section 13(3)(b), I have decided to introduce a new Building Setback Plan for Lot 1353 Town of Nightcliff (42 Chapman Road, Rapid Creek) into Schedule 9 of the NT Planning Scheme 2020 (NTPS).

I approved this amendment, without public exhibition, as I am satisfied that pursuant to section 13(1), the amendment:

- (a) promotes the purpose and objectives of the Act as it:
 - i. is consistent with the Darwin Mid Suburbs Area Plan;
 - ii. helps deliver a clear and effective planning system; and
 - iii. will promote the sustainable development of land and good design of buildings by providing orderly setbacks for single dwellings on small lots.
- (b) has merit and is in the public interest as it will provide for coordinated setbacks to preserve the amenity of adjoining development.

Pursuant to section 13(2) (b) I am satisfied the amendment is not significant enough to require exhibition as statutory exhibition was undertaken as part of the development application process.
