Port Users are advised that DTA Contractors are due to commence construction along the groyne at the Gove Boat Club on the 29th October.

Location of activity:	Gove Boat Club boat ramp
Assets/ Vessels involved	Land based fleet to carry out the construction works, including 35 tonne excavator, 35 tonne long reach excavator and one front end loader
Description of Activity:	<p>Progressive placement of rock armour along the groyne wall to carry out the construction of the new car park and loading facilities.</p> <p>For the safety and protection of marine users, all mariners are requested to maintain a safe distance from the construction equipment while traversing the area.</p> <p>The excavator operator and spotter will be available for contact on VHF Channel 16. The spotter will be monitoring marine activity & communicating with plant operator. Spotter will hold a VHF radio for comms with marine personnel to ensure safe distance is maintained at all times.</p>
