#### AMENDMENT TO NT PLANNING SCHEME 2020

#### 1. Amend Schedule 3: Exceptions

Insert

 3(-) The development and use of land for film and television production activities for a period not exceeding 12 weeks, provided that approval has been obtained from the landowner and/or controlling agency for the land; and subject to compliance with other relevant legislation. Any buildings or structures constructed for the purpose are to be removed within this period.

## **REASONS FOR DECISION**

# NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020 PA2024/0275

Pursuant to section 12(1) of the *Planning Act 1999* (the Act), I have decided to amend the NT Planning Scheme 2020 (NTPS 2020) by amending Schedule 3 (Exceptions).

The introduction of this subclause means that the NTPS 2020 does not prevent the development and use of land for film and television production activities for a period not exceeding 12 weeks, provided that approval has been obtained from the landowner and/or controlling agency for the land, and subject to compliance with other relevant legislation. Any buildings or structures constructed for the purpose are to be removed within this period.

I am satisfied that the amendment:

- (a) promotes the purpose and objectives of the Act as it ensures that the planning system is clear, comprehensive, effective, efficient and accessible to the community by clarifying and streamlining processes relating to film and television production activities in the NT.
- (b) has merit and is in the public interest as it will support temporary film and television production activities in the NT, which will remain subject to compliance and approvals from other Government agencies and landowners.

Pursuant to section 12(2) of the Act, I am satisfied that the amendment is not so significant as to require exhibition as it relates to the temporary use and development of land.
