Petroleum (Submerged Lands) Act 1981

Notice of Application for Variation – Coastal Pipeline Licence No. 5

I, James Robert Pratt, delegate of the Minister for Mining and Energy (**Minister**), under subsection 71(4) of the *Petroleum (Submerged Lands) 1981 (PSLA)*, give notice that Santos NA Barossa Pty Ltd (ACN 109 974 932) (**Santos**) has applied to vary Coastal Pipeline Licence No. 5 (NTC/PL5).

The grant instrument for NTC/PL5 currently includes coordinates at Tangent and Intersection Points under Schedule 1 of the instrument, which relates to the design route of the pipeline.

Santos has applied under subsection 71(1) of the PSLA for the instrument to be varied so that:

- the coordinates listed under Schedule 1 are at key points of the pipeline and each Kilometre Point, rather than each Tangent and Intersection Point; and
- the current map of the pipeline under Annexure A of the instrument is replaced with a new map that displays the pipeline route, as constructed, and Kilometre Points.

Any person may submit to the Minister, in writing, any matters that they wish the Minister to consider in connection with the application. Submissions must be made within 28 days to EnergyTitles.DME@nt.gov.au.

Utilities Commission Act 2000

Notice of Variation to the Electricity Industry Performance Code

In accordance with section 24(7) of the *Utilities Commission Act 2000*, the Commission gives notice that it has made a variation to the Electricity Industry Performance Code (the **Code**), which will commence on 1 July 2026.

The varied Code resolves misalignment between the Australian Energy Regulator Guidelines and the Code, and provides greater clarity regarding exemptions and obligations. The Code was last refined in 2024. To develop the current Code, the Commission undertook a public consultation process and heard from licenced electricity retailers, government departments, researchers, and other stakeholder groups.

Declaration of General Restricted Area

The Northern Territory Liquor Commission, pursuant to section 172(1) of the *Liquor Act 2019* (the **Act**) declares the area of land described in Schedule 1 to be a general restricted area in which liquor is prohibited without a permit pursuant to section 201(2) of the Act, for the period commencing upon the release of this notice and effective for a period of 99 years.

The prohibitions or restrictions in the general restricted area pursuant to section 172(3) of the Act are contained in Schedule 2.

All that land identified as being within NT Portion 01646 and known as Baghetti Family Outstation, commencing at Point 1 in the north, then generally south east to Point 2 then generally south west to Point 3, then generally north west to Point 4 then generally north east to the point of commencement, as depicted in Annexure One of the Decision Notice LC2026/001 issued by the Northern Territory Liquor Commission on 26 February 2026. The boundaries of the subject General Restricted Area are declared in accordance with section 177 of the *Liquor Act 2019* (NT).

A plan of the subject General Restricted Area – Baghetti Family Outstation, may be inspected at the office of the Director of Liquor Licensing, Darwin, Northern Territory.

Schedule 2

With reference to decision LC2026/001 dated 26 February 2026, the prohibitions and restrictions imposed by the Northern Territory Liquor Commission in the declaration are:

- a) The Director of Liquor Licensing must consult with the Baghetti Family Outstation Alcohol Management Plan Group approved by the community on 18 December 2025, and as may be varied from time to time when considering:
 - i) an application for a liquor permit;
 - ii) the conditions of a liquor permit, including the places at which, the quantities of and the types of liquor that may be possessed and consumed by the permit holder;
 - iii) suspension of a permit; or
 - iv) revocation of a permit.
 - b) The Director of Liquor Licensing may on their own initiative, provided they have taken reasonable steps to consult with the Baghetti Alcohol Management Group, suspend a liquor permit of a resident of the general restricted area for a period of up to six months with immediate effect.
