<p>This application is only for the use of customers who are not residents of the Northern Territory. The form cannot be used as a substitute by new residents who have not yet enrolled with the Motor Vehicle Registry.</p> <p>The person using this form must be a visitor or holidaying in the territory for a short period of time, a maximum of 3 months.</p> <p>This form must not be used if the person has any intention to undertake work/employment or becoming a resident at a later date. People who have recently arrived in the NT with an intention of staying for a period more than 3 months or who have arrived in the NT to undertake work or employment will need to enrol at their local Motor Vehicle Registry prior to being able to conduct a vehicle registration transaction.</p> <p>A Licenced Motor Vehicle Dealer (LMVD) who holds a Dealer Authorisation Identity Certificate (DAIC) can submit this application to the MVR on behalf of their customer. The application must include copies of all supporting documentation identified in the checklist.</p> <p>An individual, who is not a NT resident can apply to transfer a NT registered vehicle into their name by completing this form and supplying ALL relevant supporting documentation identified in the checklist to the MVR.</p> <p>Persons/Body Corporates added to the MVR records using this form will have notation against their record for Evidence of Identity & Residency required and no further transactions to be processed.</p>
