REQUIREMENT ABOUT DECLARED PEST
POTATO CYST NEMATODE

I, STEPHEN JAMES WEST, Chief Inspector of Plant Health, under section 17(2) of the *Plant Health Act* and with reference to section 17(3) and (4) of the *Act*:

- (a) impose another requirement, in addition to those imposed under regulation 12 of the Plant Health Regulations, for the control of *Globodera rostochiensis* (Woll.) Skarbilovich the common name of which is potato cyst nematode (the **declared pest**) in relation to the introduction into the Territory of a plant mentioned in regulation 12(4) of the Regulations; and
- (b) unless the plant is accompanied by a government certificate or assurance certificate specifying the matter mentioned in regulation 12(4)(b)(ii) in relation to the declared pest - require the plant to be accompanied by an assurance certificate specifying the plant was grown under the related scheme.
