CONDITIONS ABOUT IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM

EXEMPTIONS FROM CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

I, KAREN MAREE AVERY, the Director, under section 31A(8) of the *Liquor Act*, exempt a licence to which section 31A(1) applies from the requirements in section 31A(5)(a) and (b) of the *Liquor Act* for twelve months from the date of the publication of this notice.

Note

Licensees are still required to comply with any other condition of their licence that is not linked to establishing whether a person has a prohibition covered by section 31A(2)(a) - (d) of the *Liquor Act*. That is, they are still required to comply with conditions of their licence that necessitate establishing the identity of a person. For example: a licensee may still have to scan identification documentation in order to ensure compliance with local permits and product controls.
