Declaration of Pest and Notifiable Pest and
Declaration of Host Plant

I, Stephen James West, Chief Inspector of Plant Health:

- (a) under section 6(2)(a) of the *Plant Health Act*, declare each of the following to be a pest (a **declared pest**):
- (i) *Pleospora papaveracea* (Poppy Fire);
 - (ii) *Peronospora meconopsidis* (syn. *P. arborescens* and *P. cristata*) (Downy Mildew);
 - (iii) *Peronospora somniferi* (Downy Mildew); and
- (b) under section 6(4) of the Act, specify that each declared pest is a notifiable pest; and
- (c) under section 8(2)(a) of the Act, declare *Papaver somniferum* (opium poppy) to be a host plant for the declared pests.
