- A copy of the Environment Minister's notice confirming that the approved environment management plan is no longer in force
- A list of blocks being surrendered.
- A map that clearly shows the blocks being retained and surrendered.
- A letter stating that no activity has been undertaken over the area being surrendered, and as such, no restoration and rehabilitation is required.
- A statement estimating the remaining petroleum resources present in the proposed surrender area, including the data, assumptions and methodologies on which those estimates are based.
- A list of all outstanding reports and samples to be submitted in relation to the proposed surrender area.
