INTERIM DEVELOPMENT CONTROL ORDER

I, MICHAEL JAMES PALMER, the Minister for Lands, Planning and Environment, in pursuance of section 10(1) of the *Planning Act*, having formed the intention to prepare a proposed control plan in respect of the land shown bounded by thick black lines and numbered "I.D.C.O. No. 5" on the map in Schedule 1, make the interim development control order specified in Schedule 2 and specify that the order is to remain in force for the period on and from the date on which this order is notified in the *Gazette* to and including 8 January 1999.

SCHEDULE 2

INTERIM DEVELOPMENT CONTROL ORDER No. 5

- (a) Development on a site —
- (i) within the area shown bounded by thick black lines and numbered "I.D.C.O. No. 5" on the map in Schedule 1; and
 - (ii) where the development will result in the site containing —
 - (A) 2 or more dwellings in one or more buildings;
 - (B) a building for tourist accommodation or recreation purposes;
 - (C) 2 or more buildings, not including a building or part of a building that contains a dwelling or dwellings or that is for tourist accommodation or recreation purposes; or
 - (D) land used for the parking of 2 or more caravans or the erection or placement and use of tents, mobile homes or cabins for the purposes of providing accommodation to members of the public,
- may only proceed with the consent, under Part 7 of *Planning Act*, of the consent authority.
- (b) The Minister is the consent authority for the purposes of an application for consent for development specified in paragraph (a).
