SIGNATURES ON PERMIT DOCUMENTATION

On recommendation from the Building Practitioners Board it has been determined that the use of a signature stamp on permit documentation is not appropriate and will not be accepted. A stamp can only be used to identify Practitioner details etc.

All documentation forming part of a certification under the NT Building Act 1993 (Building Permits, Occupancy Permits and Section 40 certificates) must be signed by the appropriate Practitioner and must be in the Practitioners own handwriting.
