1. This form may be lodged as an original only and must be printed, typed or completed in ink or biro. Alterations to information entered on the form should be crossed out (not erased or obliterated by painting over) and initialled by the parties. All signatures must be in ink or biro

3. Insert full name of the represented Adult. Address is not required.
4. Insert full name of the decision maker. Address is not required.
5. Persons who may witness this document are a Commissioner for Oaths under the *Oaths, Affidavits and Declaration Act 2010*, a legal practitioner within the meaning of the *Legal Profession Act 2006*, a Justice of the Peace under the *Justices of the Peace Act 1991*, Doctors, Nurses and other health professionals, Accountants, Chief Executive Officers of Local Government Authorities, Social Workers and Principals of Northern Territory Schools.

A witness to an instrument executed by an individual must first:

- take reasonable steps to ensure that the individual is the person entitled to sign the instrument;
- is at least 18 years of age;
- it appears to the witness that the adult understands the nature and effect of the revocation of the Advance Personal Plan, and is revoking the Advance Personal Plan voluntarily without coercion or other undue influence;
- have the individual execute the document in the presence of the witness;
- not be a party to the instrument; and
- if witnessing more than one signature, clearly state that he/she has witnessed more than one signature. (ie I have witnessed the two signatures appearing above).

After signing, witnesses must legibly write, type or stamp their names and contact address or telephone number below their signature.
