Section C: Submission of application

All aircraft - whether conventional aeroplanes, helicopters or unmanned aerial vehicles operated from ground level - must be under the control of a licensed pilot operating in accordance with the *Civil Aviation Act 1988* when spraying, spreading or dispersing agricultural chemicals.

Copies of the following must accompany your application for conventional aeroplanes and helicopters:

- Current Commercial Pilot Licence with agricultural rating endorsement.
- Evidence that the applicant is a holder of a current Spray Safe Accreditation certificate issued by the Aerial Agricultural Association of Australia.
- Current drivers licence or other official photographic ID.
- Any other pilot licences or certificates issued in another State or Territory of Australia.

Copies of the following must accompany your application for an Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) only:

- Current drivers licence or other official photographic ID.
- Any other pilot licences or certificates issued in another State or Territory of Australia.
- The below or equivalent competency units;

AHCCHM307/ 303	Prepare and apply chemicals; and
AHCCHM304	Transport, handle and store chemicals; and
AHCPMG201	Treat weeds - herbicides only; and/or
AHCPMG202	Treat plant pests, diseases and disorders – fungicides and pesticides only.
- Unmanned Aerial Operator Certificate (ReOC).
- Remote Pilot Licence (RePL).
- Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate (AROC).
