Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2012

Declarations and Approvals

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer:

- (a) under sections 250, 252 and 254(1) of the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2012* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, revoke the declarations and approvals made by the instrument entitled "Urban Community Health Clinics – Declaration of Places, Approval of Scheduled Substance Treatment Protocols and Approval for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Practitioners to Deal with Schedule 4 Substances" dated 30 April 2014 and published in *Gazette* No. S22 of 30 April 2014; and
- (b) under section 252 of the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 2012*, declare each health centre and clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A, to be a place to which Part 2.6 of the Act applies; and
- (c) under section 254(1) of the Act, approve each Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B, for each health centre or clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A; and

- (d) under section 250(1)(a) of the Act, declare each nurse or midwife practising at a health centre or clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A, to be an approved nurse or midwife (as appropriate) to supply, administer to another person and possess the Schedule 4 substances specified in the Schedule, Part C, in accordance with the Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B; and
- (e) under section 250(1)(b) of the Act, declare each Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health practitioner practicing at a health centre or clinic specified in the Schedule, Part A, to be an approved ATSI health practitioner to supply, administer to another person and possess the Schedule 4 substance specified in the Schedule, Part C, in accordance with the Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B.

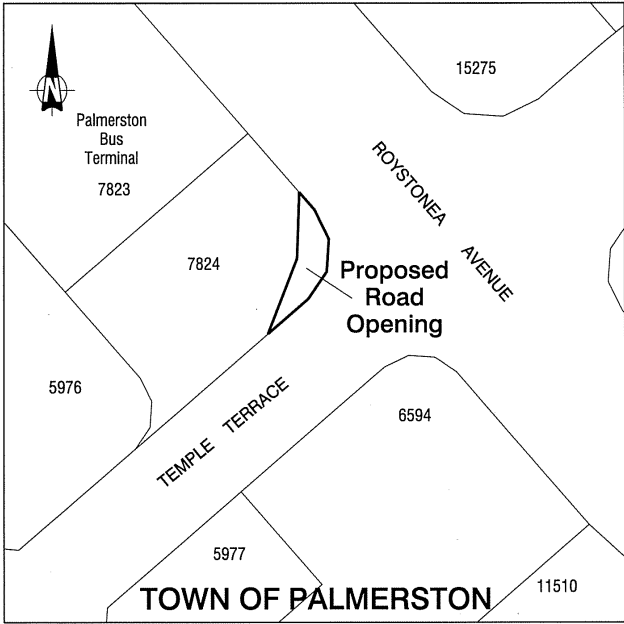

Northern Territory of Australia***Petroleum Act 1984***

Release of Information under Section 61(8)

I, Christine Lara Cakebread, the Delegate of the Minister for Mining and Industry, in pursuance of section 61(8) of the *Petroleum Act 1984* –

- (a) notify that I propose to make the information specified in the Schedule available or publicly known;
- (b) invite interested persons to give to me, within 45 days after the publication of this notice, a notice objecting to the whole or any part of the information being made available or publicly known; and
- (c) notify that if a person does not make an objection in accordance with this invitation, the person will be taken to have consented to the information being made available or publicly known.

Note

1. A notice objecting to information being made available or publicly known shall set out the person's reasons for making the objection.
2. A person may not object to information being made available or publicly known except on the ground that –
 - (a) a trade secret; or
 - (b) any other information the disclosure of which would, or could reasonably be expected to, adversely affect the person in respect of the lawful business, commercial or financial affairs of the person.
