AMENDMENT TO NT PLANNING SCHEME 2020 AMENDMENT No. 60

1. Citation

This amendment to the NT Planning Scheme 2020 may be cited as Amendment No. 60.

2. Definition


In this amendment -

"amending map" means the map, signed by the Delegate for the Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics and marked "NT Planning Scheme 2020 Amendment No. 60", deposited in the office of the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics, Darwin;

"zoning map" means the zoning map within the meaning of the NT Planning Scheme 2020.

3. Amendment of Zoning Map

The NT Planning Scheme 2020 is amended by amending the zoning map relating to the Umbakumba Locality to the extent of its inconsistency with the amending map in respect of the area of land shown on the amending map bounded by a thick black line and lettered LMR.

REASONS FOR DECISION

NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020 AMENDMENT No. 60

Pursuant to section 13(3)(b), I have decided to rezone part of NT Portion 1632 (Administrative NT Portion 7008A) Umbakumba, from Zone PS (Public Open Space) and unzoned land to Zone LMR (Low-Medium Density Residential) and amend the Umbakumba Area Plan to the extent of the inconsistency with this proposed zoning.

I have approved this amendment without exhibition, as I am satisfied, pursuant to Section 13(1), the amendment:

- (a) promotes the purpose and objectives of the Act as:
 - i. it reflects the wishes and needs of the community; and
 - ii. appropriate consultation and input has occurred, which has informed the amendment.
- (b) has merit and is in the public interest as:
 - i. it addresses a need for additional housing in Umbakumba; and
 - ii. it facilitates residential development within proximity to existing services and infrastructure; and
 - iii. it will not result in an unreasonable loss of public open space in the community.

Pursuant to section 13(2)(b) I am satisfied that the amendment is not significant enough to require exhibition as prior consultation was undertaken with the community and it has the support of the Anindilyakwa Housing Aboriginal Corporation.
