Liquor Act 2019

Declaration of High Risk Areas

- I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Minister for Alcohol Policy:
- (a) under section 211(1) of the Liquor Act 2019 and with reference to section 329(7) of the Act:
 - revoke the declaration of the high risk area made by instrument entitled
 "Declaration of Designated Area Alice Springs CBD Precinct" dated
 4 January 2011 and published in Gazette No. G2 of 12 January 2011;
 and
 - (ii) revoke the declaration of the high risk area made by instrument entitled "Revocation of Declaration and Declaration of Designated Area Palmerston CBD" dated 17 July 2015 and published in Gazette No. G30 of 29 July 2015; and

- (b) under section 210(1) of the Act, declare each of the following areas to be a high risk area:
 - the area described as "High Risk Area Karama Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/020 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (ii) the area described as "High Risk Area Palmerston Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/021 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (iii) the area described as "High Risk Area Parap Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/022 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (iv) the area described as "High Risk Area Alice Springs Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/023 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (v) the area described as "High Risk Area Fannie Bay Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/025 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (vi) the area described as "High Risk Area Bundilla Beach Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/026 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (vii) the area described as "High Risk Area Leanyer Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/027 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (viii) the area described as "High Risk Area Stuart Park Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/028 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
 - (ix) the area described as "High Risk Area Marrara Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/029 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;

- (x) the area described as "High Risk Area Malak Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/030 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
- (xi) the area described as "High Risk Area Nightcliff Foreshore Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/215 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin;
- (xii) the area described as "High Risk Area Nightcliff Precinct" and shown within the thick yellow lines depicted on Certified Plan S2023/216 lodged with the Surveyor-General, Darwin.
