# Who can apply

To be eligible, you must:

- be the owner or manager of the property of which the equipment will be used and stored
- purchase approved sheep and goat eID equipment with a compliant tax invoice
- have a Property Identification Code (PIC) for the property/parcel of land
- have current PIC/property details in the NT PIC/Property Details Register e.g. last updated this year – email NTPIC.Brands@nt.gov.au for 'update property details form'
- own 30 or more sheep and/or goats on that property/parcel of land; or
- receive sheep and/or goats regularly for sale, spelling/transit or processing.

# What equipment can you buy

For sheep and goat owners:

- RFID hand held wand reader suitable for use on sheep and goats:
  - o maximum value of \$1,500
  - o 100% incentive.

For saleyards, export yards, transit yards and processors:

- RFID panel reader suitable for use on sheep and goats:
  - o maximum value of \$2,000
  - o 50% incentive.
