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6 Interstate and Overseas AIL Licence Holders

Please read this section carefully and tick below if right for you.

So that you can drive legally in the NT, you must obtain a right to drive in the NT while complying with the conditions of your interstate or overseas AIL licence. If you obtain a right to drive be aware that:

1. during your right to drive you are still subject to the penalties and consequences that apply to your interstate or overseas AIL licence;
2. if your AIL licence is cancelled by the licensing authority that issued it, you will be deemed to be unlicensed and will no longer have a right to drive in the NT; and
3. if obtaining a right to drive contravenes the conditions of your AIL licence, you will be deemed to be unlicensed and will no longer have a right to drive in the NT. Before applying for a right to drive you should ask the licensing authority that issued your AIL licence if obtaining a right to drive in the NT will in any way breach the conditions of your AIL licence.

Apply for a right to drive

Note: You must not drive if you have lived continuously in the NT for more than three months and you do not obtain a right to drive. Your right to drive ceases to run during a period of licence suspension under another law, and resumes (or starts) as the case may be immediately after the licence suspension ends. **A person driving unlicensed is liable to a penalty not exceeding 15 penalty units or imprisonment for 12 months or both.**

7 NT Applicants

Please read this section carefully and tick below if right for you.

If you obtain an AIL licence your obligations include:

1. only driving a vehicle fitted with an approved AIL (not a commercial passenger vehicle);
2. being licensed to drive the vehicle fitted with the AIL and complying with the conditions of that licence;
3. not driving if you have a blood alcohol content equal to or exceeding 0.02% (or if your blood contains any alcohol and you have a zero alcohol limit under another law);
4. complying with conditions of use and servicing of the AIL;
5. not interfering or letting another person interfere with the proper operation of the AIL; and
6. permitting the Police to inspect the AIL on the spot.

Apply for an AIL licence

Note: An AIL licence ceases to run during a period of licence suspension under another law, and resumes (or starts) as the case may be immediately after the licence suspension ends. **An AIL licence holder driving a vehicle not fitted with an AIL, or knowingly driving when the AIL is not functioning properly is liable to imprisonment for 12 months; an AIL licence holder contravening AIL licence conditions is liable to a penalty not exceeding 15 penalty units; additionally, the AIL licence can be immediately suspended.**
