- Permits are granted under the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act* and does not negate the requirement to obtain any authority or permission required under other legislation.
- Permits are issued subject to the approval of the relevant authority in the State or Territory of Import.
- Export and Import Permits are valid for one (1) consignment only: Import permits are issued for one (1) month and Export Permits are issued for two (2) days.
- When consigning animals interstate, the consigner must securely attach the original export permit to the cage used in the shipment of these animals.
- Any intentionally misleading or false statements made on this application may result in legal action.
