

GUIDE TO ATTACHMENTS
EXTENSION OF ABANDONMENT PERIOD - EXISTING USE

The following information is provided to assist with the preparation of the application package and contains information on the content and required copies of each attachment to accompany the application for abandonment of existing use.

ATTACHMENT A - OWNER'S AUTHORISATION

ONE (1) COPY REQUIRED

If the land is owned by more than one person, written authorisation must be obtained from each person named on the title.

If the land is owned by a company or body corporate, written authorisation must be obtained from the company director/s (under company seal) or from the body corporate.

ATTACHMENT B - EVIDENCE OF EXISTING USE

ONE (1) COPY REQUIRED


Evidence of existing use is required to confirm that the use was being made immediately before the commencement or amendment of a planning scheme relating to the land under which the use ceased to be lawful. It is recommended that you liaise with Development Assessment Services staff prior to lodging your application to confirm that evidence to be provided is sufficient.

Evidence may be in the form of government correspondence verifying existing use rights, dated photographs, statutory declarations, dated approved building plans or other means.
