I, Denise Monica Turnbull, Director Mineral Titles, Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade, as the delegate of the Minister for Mining and Industry:

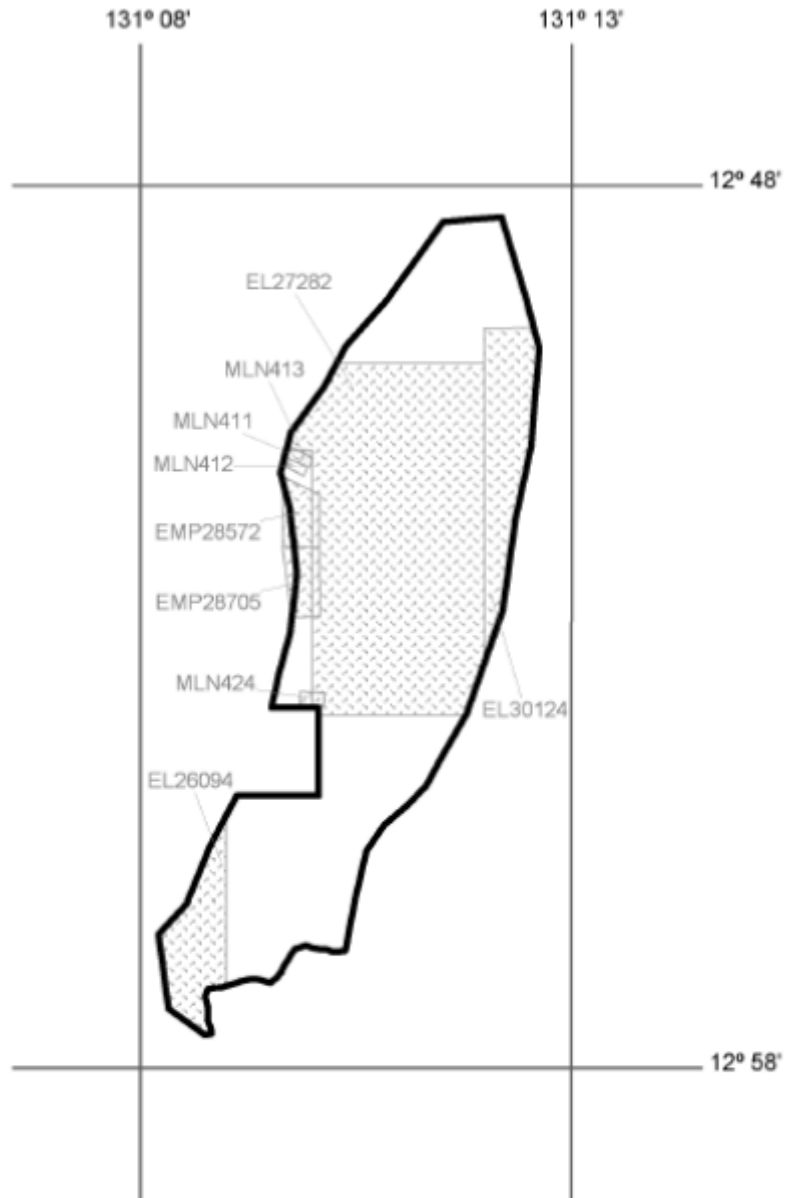
- (a) under section 113(4) of the *Mineral Titles Act 2010*, with effect on and from the day this notice is published in the *Gazette*:
 - (i) revoke the reservation made by notice entitled "General Reservation of Land on Cessation of Title (RL 30617)" dated 25 November 2014 and published in *Gazette* No. G25 on 24 June 2015 in relation to the land that is shown hatched within the thick black lines on the plan in Schedule 1; and
 - (ii) revoke the reservation made by notice entitled "General Reservation of Land (RL 30617)" dated 25 November 2014 and published in *Gazette* No. G25 on 24 June 2015 in relation to the land that is shown unhatched within the thick black lines on the plan in Schedule 1; and
- (b) under section 113(4) of the Act and with reference to section 214(1) of the Act, with effect on and from the day this notice is published in the *Gazette*, revoke the reservation made by notice entitled "Reservation from Occupation 1307" dated 14 February 1992 and published in *Gazette* No. M9 on 4 March 1992 in relation to the land that is shown within the thick black lines on the plan in Schedule 2 and that was not, on the day the reservation was made, occupied under an exploration licence, exploration retention licence or mining tenement; and

- (c) state that the reason for the revocations in paragraphs (a) and (b) is to replace the reservations mentioned in those paragraphs with a new reservation of general reserved land.

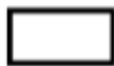

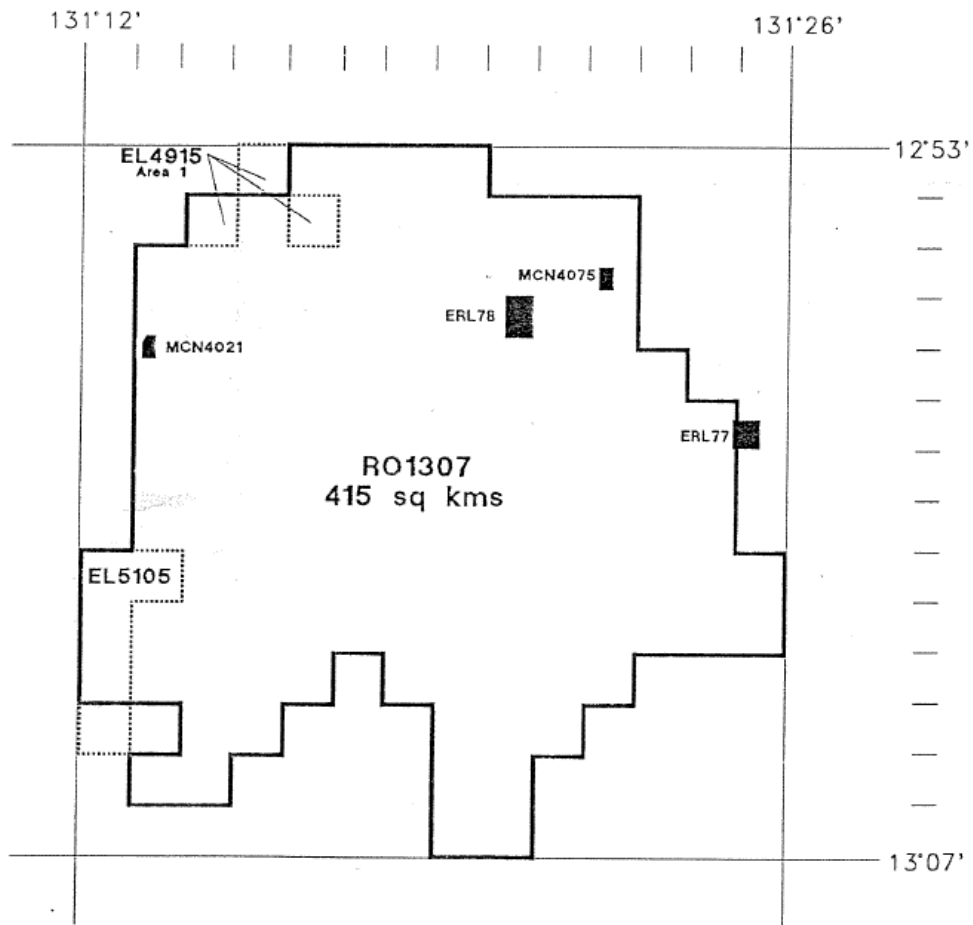


RL Area

Mineral Titles Act 2010

General Reservation of Land (RL 32761)

I, Denise Monica Turnbull, Director Mineral Titles, Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade, as the delegate of the Minister for Mining and Industry:

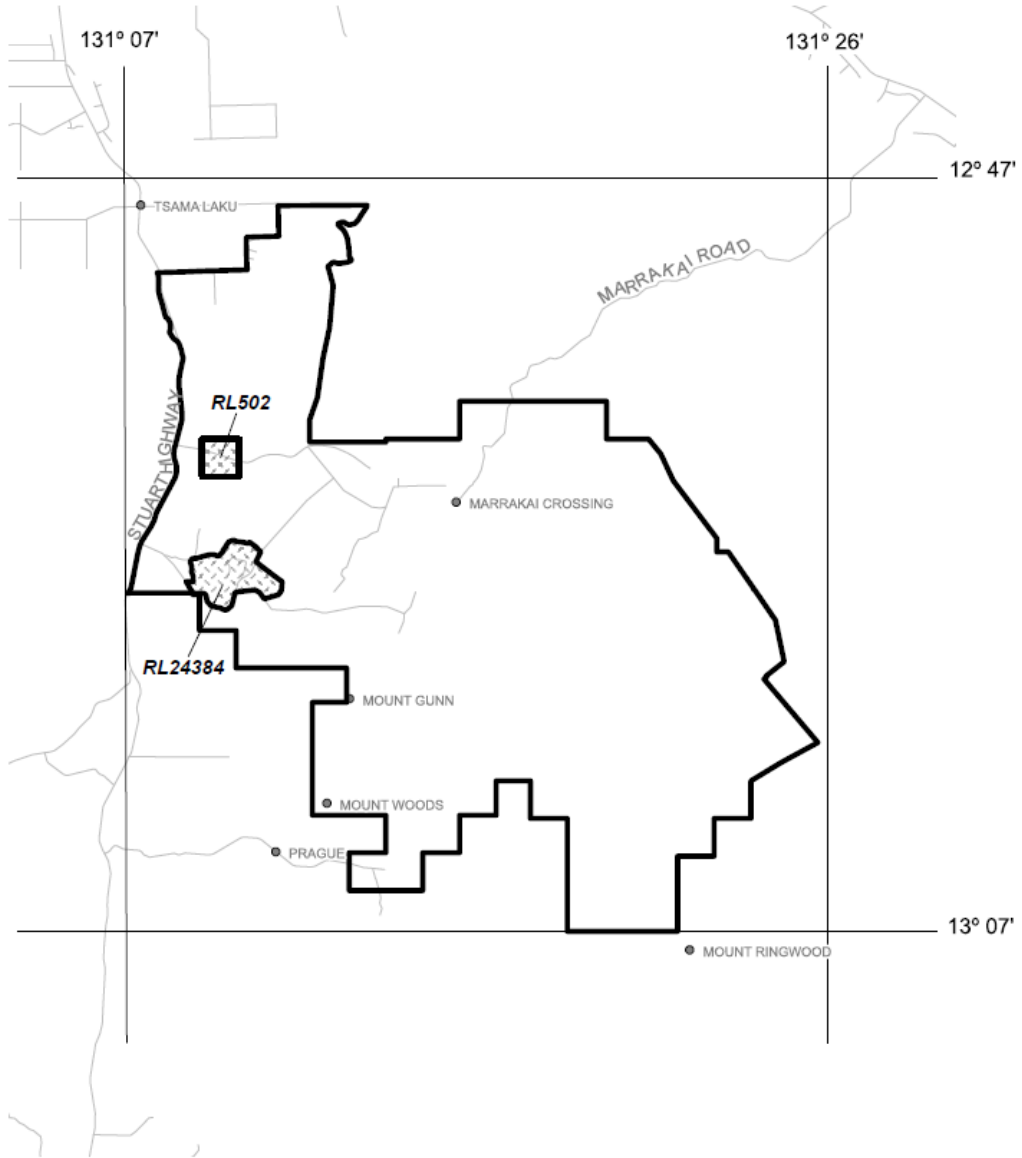
- (a) under section 113 of the *Mineral Titles Act 2010*, reserve all the land in the locality of Noonamah that is shown unhatched within the thick black lines on the plan in the Schedule from the following activities:
 - (i) exploration for, and extraction of, minerals generally;
 - (ii) exploration for, and extraction of, extractive minerals; and
- (b) give notice that:
 - (i) the reservation mentioned in paragraph (a) takes effect on and from the day this notice is published in the *Gazette*; and
 - (ii) the land specified in paragraph (a) is being reserved to enable the Power and Water Corporation to protect the future off-stream water storage area from potential impacts from mineral exploration and mining activities; and
 - (iii) a person is not entitled to apply for the grant of any mineral title in relation to the land.

Northern Territory of Australia***Petroleum Act 1984***

Release of Information under section 61(8)

I, Unnikrishnan Karumathil, the Delegate of the Minister for Mining and Industry, in pursuance of section 61(8) of the *Petroleum Act 1984* –

- (a) notify that I propose to make the information specified in the Schedule available or publicly known;
- (b) invite interested persons to give to me, within 45 days after the publication of this notice, a notice objecting to the whole or any part of the information being made available or publicly known; and
- (c) notify that if a person does not make an objection in accordance with this invitation, the person will be taken to have consented to the information being made available or publicly known.

Note

1. A notice objecting to information being made available or publicly known shall set out the person's reasons for making the objection.
2. A person may not object to information being made available or publicly known except on the ground that –
 - (a) a trade secret; or
 - (b) any other information the disclosure of which would, or could reasonably be expected to, adversely affect the person in respect of the lawful business, commercial or financial affairs of the person.
