1. Citation

This amendment to the NT Planning Scheme 2020 may be cited as Amendment No. 26.

2. Amend Schedule 3: exceptions

After

Sub-clause 3(r) in Schedule 3

Insert

3(s) the temporary use of NT Portion 1263 Hundred of Bagot (Charles Darwin National Park), Portions 1263, 2346, 2347, 2348, 2349, 2236, 1764, 1765 Hundred of Bagot, and Sections 6195 and 6210 Hundred of Bagot for 'leisure and recreation' (Side by Side Vehicle tours and storage) until 15 October 2022, subject to compliance with all other relevant Northern Territory legislation.

Reasons for Decision

NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020
AMENDMENT No. 26

Pursuant to section 12(1), I have decided to amend the NT Planning Scheme 2020 by amending Schedule 3 (Exceptions) to allow for the temporary use of Portion 1263 Hundred of Bagot (Charles Darwin National Park), Portions 2346, 2347, 2348, 2349, 2236, 1764, 1765 Hundred of Bagot, and Sections 6196 and 6210 Hundred of Bagot for 'leisure and recreation' (Side by Side Vehicle tours and storage) until 15 October 2022.

I am satisfied that the amendment:

- (a) pursuant to section 12(2), is not significant enough to require exhibition, as the amendment is for a temporary exception; and
- (b) has merit and is in the public interest as:
 - i. it will facilitate the temporary operation of a tourism venture through an iconic Darwin landmark; and
 - ii. the use is subject to compliance with all other relevant Northern Territory legislation.
