#### **REASONS FOR DECISION**

## NORTHERN TERRITORY PLANNING SCHEME 2020 AMENDMENT NO.72

Pursuant to section 12(1), I have decided to amend the NT Planning Scheme 2020, to amend Schedule 3 (Exceptions) to allow for the use of Section 6128 Hundred of Bagot (Manigurr-Ma — Centre for National Resilience), for temporary accommodation purposes in an existing fit for purpose facility by the Australian Government until 30 June 2031.

I have made this amendment because it:

- will facilitate the temporary use of an existing fit for purpose facility for an identified need by the Commonwealth;
- has merit and is in the public interest as it will accommodate a substantial workforce that would otherwise place significant pressure on the greater Darwin housing market within the greater Darwin region;

Pursuant to section 12(2), I am satisfied that the amendment is not significant enough to require exhibition, as the amendment re-establishes the previously approved use of the site for temporary staff accommodation for a fixed period of time;
