Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007

Revocation of Declaration and Declaration of Rehabilitation Programs

- I, Chanston James Paech, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, with effect on 25 March 2024:
- (a) under section 85A(1) of the Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007 (the Act) and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act 1978, revoke the declaration made by instrument entitled "Declaration of Rehabilitation Program" dated 21 July 2020 and published in Gazette No. G30 of 29 July 2020; and
- (b) under section 85A(1) of the Act and with reference to section 42(1)(b) of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, declare the following programs to be rehabilitation programs for the Act for 12 months:
 - the Marra'ka Mbarintja Men's Behaviour Change Program provided
 by Tangentyere Council Aboriginal Corporation
 (ABN 81 688 672 692);
 - (ii) the Men's Behaviour Change Program provided by CatholicCare NT (ABN 49 861 718 108); and

- (c) under section 85A(2) of the Act, specify that:
 - (i) the requirements of the program mentioned in paragraph (b)(i) are set out in the Schedule, Part A; and
 - (ii) the requirements of the program mentioned in paragraph (b)(ii) are set out in the Schedule, Part B.

Schedule

Part A

Requirements of Marra'ka Mbarintja Men's Behaviour Change Program (Tangentyere Council Aboriginal Corporation)

- 1 The defendant must, during a 5 month period, attend 16 group sessions or, if negotiated with the program facilitator, equivalent individual sessions.
- 2 The defendant must not miss 2 consecutive sessions without providing a reasonable excuse.
- In addition to the sessions mentioned in clause 1, the defendant must attend individual meetings with the program facilitator on request by the program facilitator.
- The defendant must accept that independent support will be offered to the protected person.
- 5 The defendant must:
 - (a) actively participate in the program; and
 - (b) behave respectfully; and
 - (c) not engage in conduct that is threatening or intimidating to any person.
- The defendant must sign a participation agreement and abide by the rules and arrangements set out in the agreement.

Part B

Requirements of Men's Behaviour Change Program (CatholicCare NT)

- 1 The defendant must attend 24 weekly group sessions during an 8 month period.
- In addition to the sessions mentioned in clause 1, the defendant must attend individual meetings with the program facilitator on request by the program facilitator.
- The defendant must provide any information reasonably requested by program staff to facilitate a proper assessment and satisfactory completion of the program.
- The defendant must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol at any group or individual session.

The defendant must advise program staff of any breaches of Court orders or acts of violence committed by the defendant.
