



### Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act

#### APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES

I, BARBARA ANN PATERSON, the Chief Health Officer, for the purposes of section 29(4A) of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, approve each registered nurse within the meaning of the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Act* who in the course of their duties at or from a Police Station or Police Watch House that is specified in Appendix A to possess and supply a substance listed in Schedule 2, 3, or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* in the course of his or her duties, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) a substance specified in Appendix B is to be supplied only in accordance with the permitted manner of administration indicated in Column 2 of the Appendix B; and
- (b) a substance that is listed in Schedule 2, 3 or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and is not specified in Appendix B is only to be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, optometrist or a dentist.
