



## Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act

### REDECLARATION OF PARK

I, KARL RIO HAMPTON, Minister for Parks and Wildlife, under section 24(2) of the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act*:

- (a) revoke each declaration under section 12 of the *Act* specified in Schedule 1; and
- (b) declare each of the areas of land specified in Schedule 2, to be a park; and
- (c) declare that a right, title or interest held by the Territory in respect of the land, or a part of the land (including any subsoil) within a park declared under paragraph (b) does not, on the declaration of the park, vest in the Conservation Land Corporation.

### SCHEDULE 1

#### REVOCATION OF DECLARATION OF PARKS

1. The declaration of Northern Territory Portion 2455 published in *Gazette* No. G10 of 13 March 1991 and *Gazette* No. S20 of 7 November 2002, of Dulcie Range National Park.
2. The declaration of Northern Territory Portion 2214 published in *Gazette* No. G31 of 9 August 1989 and *Gazette* No. S20 of 7 November 2002, of Watarrka National Park.

### SCHEDULE 2

#### DECLARATION OF PARKS

1. All that parcel of land known as the Dulcie Range National Park in the Northern Territory of Australia containing a total area of 18,780 hectares being the whole of Northern Territory Portion 2455 more particularly delineated on Survey Plan S97/73, lodged with the Surveyor General, Darwin, but excluding proposed Northern Territory Portion 6990 more particularly delineated on Survey Plan S2008/17 lodged with the Surveyor General, Darwin.
2. All that parcel of land known as the Watarrka National Park in the Northern Territory of Australia containing a total area of 105,200 hectares being the whole of Northern Territory Portion 6665 more particularly delineated on Survey Plan S2006/007A to D inclusive lodged with the Surveyor General, Darwin.
