**Territory Insurance Office Act**TERRITORY INSURANCE OFFICE DETERMINATION  
1/2013

I, JOHAN WESSEL ELFERINK, the Treasurer, pursuant to section 33A of the *Territory Insurance Office Act*, make the following determination.

**1. Application and Interpretation**

- (1) Subject to this Determination, the provisions of this Determination apply with effect immediately.
- (2) Territory Insurance Office Determination 212007 shall cease to have effect on and from the commencement of this Determination.
- (3) Subject to this Determination, the APRA Standards apply to the Office as follows, and subject to the following qualifications, modifications, clarifications or additions:
  - (a) The ADI Standards apply to the finance business.
  - (b) the general insurance Standards apply to the insurance business.
  - (c) the general insurance Standards apply to the MAC business, with the exception of Prudential Standard GPS 110 - GPS 118.
  - (d) Where a Prudential Standard applies to one of the businesses of the Office pursuant to this

- Determination, any reference in that Standard to any asset, liability, capital or other statement of financial position item of the Office, or to any income, expense or other statement of financial performance item of the Office, shall be read as including only such statement of financial position or statement of financial performance items of the Office as are attributable to or allocated to in with clauses 5, 6, and 7 this Determination.
- (e) References to an ADI, an insurer, a general insurer or a regulated institution shall be read as references to the Office in its conduct of the Office to which the Standard applies.
- (f) References to APRA shall be read as the Treasurer.
- (g) References to directors of an ADI or an insurer shall be read as references to members of the board of the Office.
- (h) References to the board (or Board) in relation to an ADI or an insurer shall be read as references to the board of the Office.
- (i) References to "Appointed Auditor" shall be read as references to the Auditor-General. For the purposes of the APRA Standards the Auditor-General shall be taken to be independent, to be fit and proper, and to have no conflict of interest. Any provision of the APRA Standards imposing obligations or requirements on the Appointed Auditor shall not be directly binding upon the Auditor-General, however the Office must make the necessary arrangements with the Auditor-General to enable the Auditor-General to perform, and to ensure that the Auditor-General performs, the role and requirements contemplated by the APRA Standards to be undertaken and performed by the Appointed Auditor.
- (j) References to "Appointed Actuary" shall be read as references to an actuary appointed by the Office and approved by the Treasurer. Any provision of the APRA Standards imposing obligations or requirements on the Appointed Actuary shall not be directly binding upon the Appointed Actuary, however the Office must make the necessary arrangements with the Appointed Actuary to enable the Appointed Actuary to perform, and to ensure that the Appointed Actuary performs, the role and requirements contemplated by the APRA Standards to be undertaken and performed by the Appointed Actuary.
- (k) The Office must submit to the Treasurer all certificates and reports required to be prepared by its Appointed Auditor and Appointed Actuary under the APRA Standards. Reports other than those relating to a special purpose review must be submitted on or before the day that the Office's yearly statutory accounts are required to be given to the Treasurer.
- (l) References to Commonwealth legislation that does not apply to the Office shall be disregarded.
- (m) For the purposes of the APRA Standards, the businesses of the Office shall not be taken to be related entities nor members of a conglomerate group or consolidated group. To avoid doubt, any provision of the APRA Standards that applies only to an entity that is either a member of a consolidated group or a member of a conglomerate group shall not apply to the Office or to any of the businesses of Office.
- (n) Any reference to paid up ordinary shares shall be read as including a reference to equivalent capital instruments.
- (o) Notwithstanding any provision of the APRA Standards that allows an insurer a choice of methods for determining the minimum capital requirement, the Office method referred to the "Method".
- (p) Notwithstanding any provision of the APRA Standards that allows an ADI a choice of methods for determining the credit risk and operational risk, the Office must use the standardised method referred to as the "Standardised Approach".
- (q) For the purposes of the APRA Standards, depositors with the Office contracted through a common broker shall be taken to constitute a group of related counterparties and must be treated as counterparties constituting a single risk.
- (r) The Office shall not engage in any activities determined by the Treasurer to be trading book activities. In determining whether activities constitute trading book activities the Treasurer shall have regard to any APRA Standards or guidance notes applicable to ADIs that provide guidance as to the distinction between banking book activities and trading book activities.
- (s) Transitional provisions in the APRA Standards shall apply such that if the relevant provision is applicable to a general insurer or an ADI as the case may be as at the date of commencement of this Determination, the provision shall apply to the Office by virtue of this Determination, and if the date of commencement of the provision in accordance with its terms is after 1 January 2008, that date of commencement apply in its application to the Office
- (t) To the extent of any inconsistency between the APRA Standards and the *Act*, the Regulations or any other instrument of a legislative or administrative character made under the *Act*, the provisions of that instrument shall prevail.
- (4) In this Determination:
- "ADI Standards" means APRA Standards applicable to ADIs.
- "ADI" means Authorised Deposit-taking Institution.
- "APRA" means the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority.
- "APRA Standards" means the Prudential Standards applied by APRA under the *Insurance Act 1973* and the *Banking Act 1959* as are current from time to time.
- "businesses of the Office" means the following businesses:
- finance business;
  - insurance business;
  - MAC business.
- "finance business" means the part of the Office's business that relates to the provision of services defined in the *Act*.
- "insurance business" means the part of the Office's business that relates to the provision of insurance services.
- "general insurance Standards" means APRA Standards applicable to general insurers.
- "MAC business" means the part of the Office's business that relates to administration of the motor accident

compensation scheme established by the *Motor Accidents (Compensation) Act*, the Motor Accidents (Compensation) Fund and any other related matters.

## 2. Reporting

- (1) The Office shall, not later than 6 weeks after the last day of March, September and December of each year or such longer period as the Treasurer, in writing, permits, lodge a return with the Treasurer relating to the 3 months preceding the last day of that March, September or December, as the case may be.
- (2) The Office shall, not later than 4 months after the last day of June of each financial year or such longer period as the Treasurer, in writing, permits, lodge a return with the Treasurer relating to the financial year preceding that last day of June, based on the audited financial information for that financial year.
- (3) Returns referred to in clause must:
  - (a) contain details of the Office's compliance with and performance with respect to the Prudential Standards applicable pursuant to this Determination; and
  - (b) contain any of the following information as is required by the Treasurer:
    - (i) information about each of the businesses of the Office;
    - (ii) information about the Office as a whole; and
  - (c) be in accordance with the forms published by APRA as existing or in force from time to time, subject to such alterations as may be approved or directed by the Treasurer to take account of the modified application of the APRA Standards to the Office as provided for in clause 1(3).
- (4) Whenever the Office is required to lodge a return with the Treasurer under this clause 2, the Office must also lodge a copy of the return with the Under Treasurer.

## 3. Accounting Records

- (1) The Office must maintain accounting records that correctly record and explain the transactions and financial position of the Office.
- (2) The Office must retain the records for at least 7 years after the completion of the last transaction to the records relate.

## 4. Separate Accounts and Consolidated Accounts

- (1) The Office must maintain separate accounts for each of the businesses of the Office.
- (2) The must be maintained as if of the businesses of the Office were conducted by a separate entity.
- (3) The Office must also consolidate the accounts for each of the businesses of the Office into accounts for the Office as a whole for the purposes of the *Act*.

## 5. Allocation of Statement of Financial Position Items

- (1) The Office must allocate any asset, liability, capital or other statement of financial position item that is attributable to one of the businesses of the Office as an asset, liability, capital or other statement of financial position item for that business. Where any statement of financial position item has not been allocated, or allocated in a manner deemed inappropriate by the Treasurer, the Office shall allocate the item as determined by the Treasurer.
- (2) If any asset, liability, capital or other statement of financial position item is attributable to more than one of the

businesses of the Office, the Office must apportion the item amongst such businesses. Where any statement of financial position item that is attributable to more than one of the businesses of the Office has not been apportioned, or apportioned in a manner deemed inappropriate by the Treasurer, the Office shall apportion the item as determined by the Treasurer.

- (3) The statement of financial position items allocated to a business under subclause (1) or subclause (2) may only be applied for that business.
- (4) Subclause (3) does not prevent any arrangement between the finance and insurance businesses in relation to any of the allocated statement of financial position items if the arrangement is one that could have been made by separate entities conducting the businesses at arm's length with each other. All such arrangements must be clearly disclosed in the returns provided to the Treasurer.
- (5) Subclause (3) does not prevent any arrangement between the MAC business and the other businesses of the Office in relation to any of the allocated statement of financial position items if the arrangement is one that could have been made by separate entities conducting the businesses at arm's length with each other. All such arrangements must be clearly disclosed in the returns provided to the Treasurer.

## 6. Allocation of Statement of Financial Performance Items

- (1) The Office must allocate any Income, expense or statement financial performance item that is attributable to one of the businesses of the Office as income, an expense or other statement of financial performance item for that business. Where any statement of financial performance item has not been allocated, or allocated in a manner deemed inappropriate by the Treasurer, the Office shall allocate the item as determined by the Treasurer.
- (2) If any income, expense or other statement of financial performance item is attributable to more than one of the businesses of the Office, the Office must apportion the item amongst such businesses. Where any statement of financial performance item that is attributable to more than one of the businesses of the Office has not been apportioned, or apportioned in a manner deemed inappropriate by the Treasurer, the Office shall apportion the item as determined by the Treasurer.
- (3) The statement of financial performance items allocated to a business under subclause (1) or subclause (2) may only be applied for that business.
- (4) Subclause (3) does not prevent any arrangement between the finance and insurance businesses in relation to any of the allocated statement of financial performance items if the arrangement is one that could have been made by separate entities conducting the businesses at arm's length with each other. All such arrangements must be clearly disclosed in the returns provided to the Treasurer.
