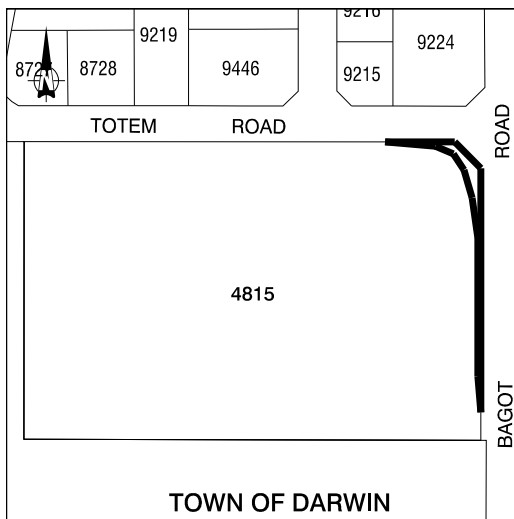
Control of Roads Act**ORDER TO OPEN ROAD**

Public and Environmental Health Act

NOTIFICATION OF MAKING GUIDELINES

I, STEVEN JAYE SKOV, Chief Health Officer, under section 101(4) of the *Public and Environmental Health Act*, give notice of the following:

The Department of Health has developed "Guidelines for Land Capability Assessment for On-site Wastewater Management" to assist proponents of unsewered development proposals to: assess the capability of the site to sustainably manage wastewater within allotment boundaries;

identify public and environmental health impacts of on-site wastewater management and in particular the effect on groundwater and surface water on sites; and

identify management programs to minimise these impacts; in addition to best practice regulation.

Therefore;

- a) I have adopted the guidelines entitled "Guidelines for Land Capability Assessment for On-site Wastewater Management"
- b) The guidelines take effect on 19 March 2014;
