All that parcel of land in the Town of Katherine in the Northern Territory of Australia containing an area of 7 630 square metres more or less, designated Lot 3344(A) and bounded by lines described as follows: commencing at the most northern corner of Lot 3109(A); thence by lines bearing 218 degrees 27 minutes 10 seconds 12 metres, bearing 308 degrees 27 minutes 10 seconds 636 metres, bearing 38 degrees 27 minutes 10 second 12 metres, bearing 128 degrees 27 minutes 10 seconds 636 metres, to the point of commencement.
