NOTES:

1. If the brand you are looking for is **NOT** on this list, then unfortunately it is **not available**.
2. When a brand is cancelled it cannot be re-registered for minimum of 5 years, therefore you will not find it in this list or on the **NT Brands Register Search Database**, as it means it is not available.
3. **You must choose 3 brands** to write on your Application form, as surrounding properties are checked to ensure none are similar or previously registered in the same region.
If your choices are not approved, you will be required to choose another 3 for consideration.
4. Even if you are intending to only brand using a Distinctive (symbol) Brand, you must first register an approved three-letter brand.
5. Once all documentation is submitted and correct, application/s are processed within 30 days.

Brands for use on Aboriginal Land Trust

To register a Brand on Aboriginal Land Trust (ALT) you must first discuss your proposal with either the Northern Land Council (NLC) or Central Land Council (CLC). These Land Councils act as a body corporate established pursuant to, and has statutory functions under, the *Aboriginal Land Rights Act* and provides administrative support to the Land Trust.

You will most likely be required to enter into a legal agreement with the Land Council and ALT for example; *licence agreement, grazing licence, Section 19 Land Use Agreement, mustering agreement, lease* etc. Once all parties involved in the agreement have agreed and signed the appropriate agreement, then paperwork can be submitted in order to register a NT Brand on the ALT.

NT Brands options may include:

- Special Permission to use an existing registered NT Brand temporarily on ALT (for short term agreements i.e. less than 3 months); or
- Register NT Brand for the period of the agreement as per Land Council conditions and/or restrictions. May include an *Application for Three-letter Brand* or *Request to Change the Run*.

NOTE: You must have a signed agreement in place with the Land Council plus follow instructions as listed below. Without the supporting documentation from NLC or CLC your application / request will be returned unprocessed – payment of application will not be accepted.

You should always discuss your requirements with your Regional Livestock Biosecurity Officer, before submitting Application/s.
