

Guideline for producing 1080 baiting maps

A map for each listed property **MUST** be attached to your application for a wild dog 1080 PAMA and permit.

Please attach the best map of each property, ensuring they are marked with the all the features listed below. The map needs to be clear and well-marked so it can be read as a scan or fax as well as the original.

Every dwelling or Community Living Area (CLA) that is not on the property, but within 3km of a baiting site, must be shown.

To prepare maps, please use the following symbols:

- Dwelling - own
- Dwelling – adjacent and other ownership
- Community Living Area (CLA)
- △ Constructed roadside stops – rest areas, monuments, road houses and similar
- † Location of 1080 warning signs
- ⊕ Public access points to property
- Watering points, water bodies including dams and bores, etc.

Other features to include are:

- Watercourses - mark with a blue line
- Property boundaries
- Roads adjoining boundary
- Area to be baited – outline the area clearly
- Internal roads and tracks (indicate those to be used for bait distribution)
- Aerial tracks for bait distribution (if applicable).
