Declarations and Approval**

I, Hugh Crosbie Heggie, Chief Health Officer:

- (a) under section 252 of the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act*, declare the health centre specified in the Schedule, Part A, to be a place to which Part 2.6 of the Act applies; and
- (b) under section 254(1) of the Act, approve each Scheduled substance treatment protocol specified in the Schedule, Part B, for the health centre specified in the Schedule, Part A; and
- (c) under section 250(1)(a) of the Act, declare each nurse practising at the health centre specified in the Schedule, Part A who has the qualifications specified in the Schedule, Part C, to be an approved nurse to supply, administer to another person and possess the Schedule 4 substances specified in the Schedule, Part D, in accordance with the applicable Scheduled substance treatment protocols specified in the Schedule, Part B.
