Definitions

ANZSCO Australian and New Zealand Standard Classification of Occupation is a skill-based occupation classification standard used by the Australian Bureau of Statistics.

ANZSCO

Skill Level Skill level refers to the level of skill required to competently perform the tasks associated with an occupation. ANZSCO skill levels are generally commensurate with the following qualification levels:

Skill Level 1 - Bachelor degree or higher qualification

Skill Level 2 - Associate degree, Advanced diploma or Diploma

Skill Level 3 - Certificate III or Certificate IV

Skill Level 4 - Certificate II or Certificate III

Skill Level 5 - Certificate I or compulsory secondary education
