



protect your dogs

Ehrlichiosis, an tick-borne dog disease, has been detected in the Northern Territory and is present in most local government areas, including Darwin, Palmerston, Darwin rural area, Katherine and many remote areas.

- Have your dogs on a tick control program. Tick collars and spot-ons are the best primary protection used in combination with tick control tablets and chews.
- Ensure tick infestations in the house yard are managed by a pest controller.
- Avoid taking your dogs into tick-infested areas.
- Take particular care when bush-walking with your dog.
- Inspect your dogs daily for ticks.
- Check when travelling or boarding your dog with your vet or local boarding kennel.
- Be on the lookout for signs of ehrlichiosis and seek advice from your vet.
