Amendment to Determination Relating to Building Practitioners

- I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Minister for Racing, Gaming and Licensing, under section 24G(a) of the *Building Act 1993* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act 1978*, amend the instrument entitled "Revocation of Determinations and Determinations Relating to Building Practitioners" dated 23 September 2019 and published in *Gazette* No. G40 on 2 October 2019 by omitting clause 1(1)(a)(ii) in Schedule 1 and inserting:
- (ii) successful completion of the following units for a CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building and Construction (Building):
 - (A) each of the following core units:

Approval of Traffic Infringement Detection Device

BEE III Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar

I, Jamie Andrew Chalker, Commissioner of Police:

under to section 44(1) of the Traffic Act 1987 ("Act") and with reference to (a)

section 43 of the Interpretation Act 1978, I hereby revoke the instrument dated

11 February 2011 appearing in *Gazette* G8, 23 February 2011 approving the

"BEE III Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar" as a traffic infringement

detection device.

(b) under to section 44(1) of the Act and with reference to section 44AA of the Act,

I hereby approve the "BEE III Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar"

manufactured by MPH Industries, as a traffic infringement detection device.

(c) under to section 44(2) of the Act, I hereby specify that the approval of the device

under paragraph (b) is subject to the condition that it must be tested for accuracy

as follows:

(i) the correct operation and accuracy of each BEE III, Automatic Same

Direction Traffic Radar is to be tested, not less than once in each day that

the device is used for the purpose of the Act by a person operating it during

the day, in accordance with the testing procedures set out in the document

published by the manufacturer and entitled "Operation and Service Manual";

(ii) the accuracy of the calibration and parameter performance of each BEE III

Automatic Same Direction Traffic Radar is to be tested not less than once in

each 12 month period by a person approved under section 44(3) of the Act

and sealed shut at the end of the testing procedure; and

(iii) if the device becomes unsealed, is opened or otherwise damaged, as soon

as reasonably practicable after that occurs by a person approved under

section 44(3) of the Act.

Return to Work Act 1986

Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Advisory Council Members – Expressions of Interest

The Attorney-General and Minister for Justice invites nominations from interested persons within the Northern Territory who:

- (a) include members with a wide range of experience extending as far as possible across all major industry sectors in the Territory; and
- (b) include representatives of organisations representing employers, and representatives of organisations representing employees, in equal or approximately equal numbers; and
- (c) include persons with expertise in the rehabilitation of injured workers; and
- (d) include persons with expertise in the insurance industry.

The Workers Rehabilitation and Compensation Advisory Council comprises of no more than ten members appointed by the Minister and a member constituting the Authority.

The Council's functions are to:

- (a) to keep the operation of this Act under review;
- (b) to make recommendations to the Minister on possible improvements to the administration of this Act, or the statutory scheme for the rehabilitation and compensation of injured workers in the Territory;
- (c) to carry out investigations, at the request of the Minister, into questions about the rehabilitation and compensation of injured workers and to report to the Minister on the results of the investigations;
- (d) to perform any other advisory functions relating to workers rehabilitation and compensation as the Minister directs.

An appointed member holds office for the period, not exceeding two years, specified in the instrument of appointment. Sitting fees are available to members.
