

Seed analysis and destruction submission form

Unsolicited seed packets can be dropped off for analysis and destruction at these seed collection points between 8am and 4.21pm, Monday to Friday:

- Berrimah Farm Science Precinct Agricultural Laboratory
- Northern Territory Farmers Association Coolalinga office
- Katherine Research Station
- Arid Zone Research Institute reception area (Alice Springs)
- Barkly House (Tennant Creek).

Avoid handling the seeds. Secure them within the original packaging and seal in an envelope or plastic bag. You should complete as much information as possible on this form, but you can also drop seeds at these collection points anonymously. Printed forms will be available at all seed collection points.

Place the envelope or bag and completed seed destruction submission form in the collection bin. Once accepted, seeds become the property of the Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade.
