Notice of Proposed Grant of an Exploration Permit (Petroleum)

Petroleum Act 1984 Section 18

Nature of act(s): The grant of a permit under the Petroleum Act 1984, gives the person to whom it is granted the exclusive right, for a term of up to 5 years, to explore for petroleum and to carry on such operations and execute such works as are necessary for that purpose in the area covered by the permit including (but not limited to) use of machinery and equipment for carrying out works, removal of material for testing, use of water resources for domestic use and to seek renewals. A permit may be renewed no more than twice. If petroleum is discovered in a permit area, production licences and/or retention licences may subsequently be granted. Further information about the

Petroleum Act 1984 may be obtained from the Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade.

Objections under section 19 of the Petroleum Act 1984: Pursuant to section 19 of the Petroleum Act 1984, a person who has an estate or interest in relation to land comprised in, an area covered by the proposed grant may, within 2 months after the notification day, lodge in writing to the Minister, objection to the proposed grant. Such objection may be lodged at the Office of the Minister for Mining c/- Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade.
