Notice to the Owner of the white hulled yacht 'Abrolhos Pearl'

Re: Regional Harbourmasters Notice

Section 43, Ports Management Act

The Regional Harbourmaster (RHM) of the Port of Darwin in the Northern Territory of Australia, having previously issued a 14-day direction (on 27 November 2025) to the owner of the white hulled yacht 'Abrolhos Pearl' to take preventative action in regard to the vessel and having received no response to that direction, is now of the opinion that the above-mentioned non-commercial vessel, because of its condition and location (aground on Lameroo beach Darwin) is:

- Unseaworthy, and
- The cost of repairing it to make it seaworthy, or the cost of storage and sale, exceeds its value.

Accordingly, the Regional Harbourmaster now intends, at the owner's cost, to remove the vessel and take such further action as necessary after 28 days of the issue of this second direction, to:

- Destroy it and all fittings and equipment on board
