Coastal mariners are advised that marine survey operations will be undertaken within the Charles Point Artificial Reef Project boundary with two vessels working concurrently. Mariners transiting the area are requested to keep a safe distance and maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 16.	
Date and time of activity:	2 September 2026 to 10 September 2026 Daylight operations
Assets/ Vessels involved	“Wai Nawana” and “MV Borroloola”
Description of Activity:	In-Depth Innovations Pty Ltd advises that marine survey operations will be undertaken within the Charles Point Artificial Reef Project boundary between Wednesday 2 September and Thursday 10 September 2026, with two vessels working concurrently. Mariners transiting the area are requested to keep a safe distance and maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 16.
Location of activity	The boundary is a right-angled triangle with the right angle at vertex V2. Side lengths are 3.93 km (northern, east-west), 2.43 km (eastern, north-south) and 4.62 km (hypotenuse). Positions are in degrees and decimal minutes (DDM) with decimal degree equivalents for GIS and acquisition software.
