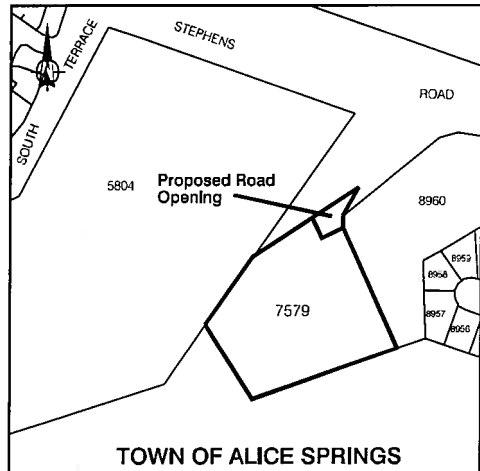

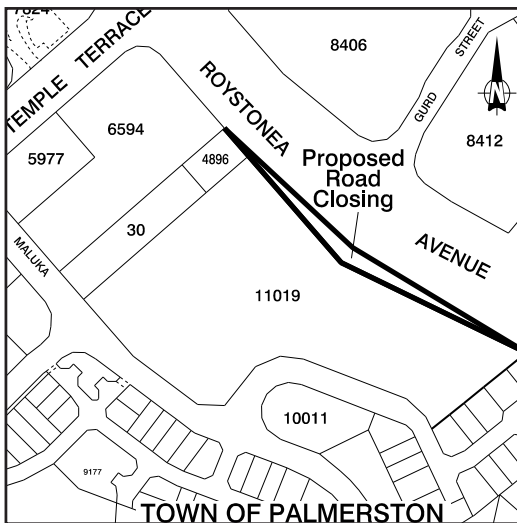

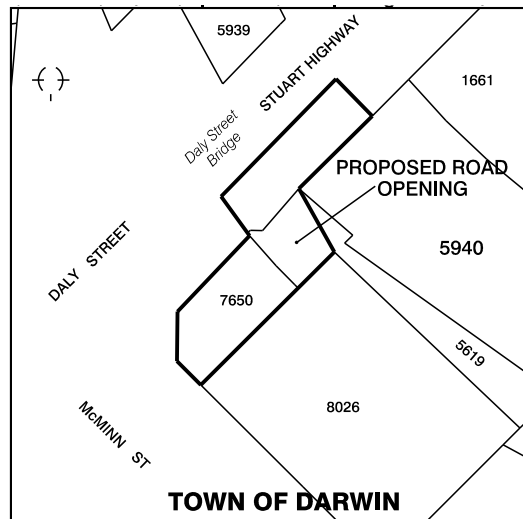

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Legal Profession Act 2006

NOTICE

1. The run off cover is limited to activities of the practitioners whilst acting within their role as an employee or partner of Clayton Utz and in connection with the legal practice of Clayton Utz.
 - (b) The legal practitioners that are covered by this exemption must provide the Law Society Northern Territory with a copy of the terms of the alternative professional indemnity insurance and provide evidence to the Law Society Northern Territory that they are covered by this alternative professional indemnity insurance.
